

## Frequently Asked Questions for Answers in Genesis (AiG) DC 2007 Conference Callers

### Christian Leaders Meeting (CLM)

*Note:* Pastors register for the CLM *in March* by RSVP, by calling the 866 Toll Free Number or accepting the invitation when our local callers call.

If a Pastor wants to bring his wife or another Christian leader from his church, this is OK – we just need a count.

Also when calling churches, if the pastor or another leader seems truly interested in Answers In Genesis, but unable to attend the CLM for whatever reason – ask (if you think appropriate) if they would be interested in distributing bulletin inserts to advertise the conference?

**Q: I called a pastor and he said he sent in the RSVP, should I get the information again?**

A. It is not necessary to get the information again, since the RSVP will be sent to our Volunteer Coordinator, Cris Loop, who will enter it into the database. It would be good to email Cris Loop so she knows it is coming: looptroop4@cox.net. You will be making the reminder call to the Pastor, so please keep a record of which of your pastors have accepted.

**Q: I called a pastor and he said he called the toll free number on the Invitation, and registered for the CLM. Should I get his information again and enter it into the database (DB)?**

A: No. Telephone registrations will be sent to each County Coordinator (CC) in MP3 format by the "Telephone CLM Coordinator". Your CC will:

- listen to the MP3,
- look up the church in the DB
- register the Pastor for the CLM in the DB
- note in the DB *Notes* Field that the pastor called in to register for the CLM, and
- will notify you (the Caller responsible for that church),

so you have a record of who to call for the "reminder call" on March 22-24. Please keep a Word or text file record of all who registered for the CLM in your county, so you can send this to your CC on Mar. 5 and Mar. 24.

### Registration for the AiG Conference (May 18 & 19, 2007)

*Note:* The AiG Conference begins with the session on Friday evening at 7 pm, and continues through Saturday. The daytime sessions on Friday are not considered part of the Conference, and are free to students, parents and grandparents.

**Q: What does *registration* mean?**

A: For the Washington DC Area event, there are 4 registrations:

1. Pastors register for the CLM (see above)
2. There is also a pre-registration for the Free Student Meeting on Friday May 18 if you are a home school group or a Christian School group is over 25.
3. You can also pre-register your 7 to 10 year child for the Creation Adventure Workshop.
4. Registration for the event itself is at the door.

**Q: How do I register for the Conference / register early?**

A: Registration is at the door - there is no early registration for the Conference itself. Pre-registration is only available/required for:

1. Creation Adventure Workshop (CAW) – also called Children's workshop. Go to the AiG web site above and click on the registration link. **AiG accepts credit cards.**
2. Student groups over 25 – you call the 866 Toll Free Number.

**Q: Why does the AiG Event Web Site say "Register Online" when the brochure and 866 Toll Free Number says that "registration is at the door"?**

A: *Register Online* refers to the Creation Adventure Workshop only.

**Q: What is the cost to attend the conference? For 1 person, for a family?**
